



Fishbowl Session on Smart Globe, hosted representatives of the Government of Armenia, heads of international organizations, ambassadors and opinion leaders on the topics of Smart Future, Smart Earth and Smart Cities. Among the presenting organizations were Ministries of Economy and Environment, United Nations Country Representation, Embassy of France, AECOM, ERI and others.

Panel Discussion on **Reshaping Innovation Ecosystems**, which included representatives from the Ministry of Economy, Asian Development Bank, United Nations Development Programme, and the World Bank, explored the role of **development finance**. Simultaneously, representatives of 500 Startups and University of Maryland discussed the opportunities and impact of **venture finance** in reshaping innovation ecosystems.












GIF TALKS

In its effort to make GIF an event that engages the largest possible number of participants, in partnership with leading scientific and technological centers FAST organized 11 GIF Talks, which provided the chance to additional 300+ local students and researchers to interact with the distinguished national and international experts.









The Forum was truly global, gathering not only revered speakers but also participants from around the world. Alongside individual participants, within the framework of FAST's **international partnerships**, special emphasis is put on the inclusion of international delegations at the Forum. This year a **special delegation** from the **Republic of Rwanda** attended GIF, building upon the partnership between FAST and the Rwandan government aimed at creating a bridge between Armenia and the African continent with one of the forerunners of its innovation ecosystem.











As part of the FAST - UNDP cooperation, a special edition of Impact nightOut entertainment event was co-hosted within the frames of the Forum.

The evening gathered **over IOOO** impact enthusiasts, innovation evangelists, entrepreneurs and tech gurus, giving them a platform to share various innovative financing mechanisms aimed at mobilizing additional capital for Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) acceleration.

The event also featured live music by local bands and DJs, and an expo area where partners with cultural impact on Armenia's national heritage presented the history and ongoing projects through a modern lens.

Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan jointly with the Minister of Environment Erik Grigoryan and FAST Founding CEO Armen Orujyan made an announcement that the Government has launched the IO.IO.IO Tree initiative to plant IO million trees across the Republic on IO October, 2020.
